

Memberships- How do I pay? Where do I get forms? Why do I need to pay?

If you are patrolling or competing with the club this season you must pay your membership immediately. Under no circumstances is any individual to train/compete unless they have returned their signed membership form and paid their \$60 membership fee for the season. You will not be covered under the clubs insurance policy if you are participating in any of these activities and the incident will be reported to the clubs management committee. Your membership cannot be processed until fees have been paid and the form has been returned to the office.

Transfers

If you have previously been a member of another Surf Life Saving Club then you will need to complete a transfer form and hand this in with their membership form. Members cannot patrol or compete until their transfer has been approved and their membership has been processed. A transfer form can be found on the club website.

Proficiencies

If you are patrolling or competing for the club then you must also hold your current Bronze Medallion Proficiency certificate. This means you either gained your bronze last season or completed your proficiency last season. If you didn't do your proficiency last season, you must not patrol or compete until you complete your proficiency at the club proficiency day. If you did your proficiency last season then you must redo your proficiency again this season to be eligible to patrol or compete. The club proficiency dates are

These are the only proficiency dates for this season so please ensure you attend these days

Fundraisers

These are being confirmed by the club and will be a compulsory part of the Clubs Good Member Policy. Details will be advised when known

Patrol Hours

To qualify to compete in the Branch, State and Australian titles you must meet Surf Life Saving Australia's minimum patrol hr requirement. This is based on a calendar year. In this instance 1st January 2010 – 31st December 2010

Active members- will require 25 patrol hours for the calendar year

Active members (who transferred in this year) will require 4 hrs per month from time of transfer for the calendar year. Ie) Rowena Boat transfers from Kurrawa on October 7th 2010. She will be required to complete 12 patrol hours before December 31st 2010 to compete at the 2010 Branch, state and Aussie Titles

Active Reserve Members – will require 12 patrol hours for the calendar year (please note you must apply to the club committee for active reserve status- just because you were an active reserve member at your last club doesn't mean that this automatically transferred over to Currumbin- You must obtain a letter from your previous club advising of your length of membership and active reserve status. Please address all applications to the Secretary –PO Box 47 Currumbin Qld 4223.

Long Service Members – are exempt from patrols (please note you must apply to the club committee for long service status- just because you were long service at your last club doesn't mean that this automatically transferred over to Currumbin- You must obtain a letter from your previous club advising of your length of membership and long service status. Your membership will be regarded as long service but you will still be required to complete 12 patrol hours over the course of the season for a period of 2 season before you will be fully classified as a Currumbin Long Service member. You need to contact club Captain, Mark Goodwin immediately on 0407 936 798 to arrange a substitute. Any failure to contact the Club Captain and notify him of your absence from patrol will result in a breach of the Clubs Good Member Policy

Club Swimmers

Currumbin Swimmers are available from the Surf Club- Men's swimmers are \$30. Women's Bikinis are \$45 and the one piece swimmers are \$50.
